


Crisis Residence Center







Mosaic Mental Health's Crisis Residence Center provides a safe, home-like setting for people experiencing a psychiatric crisis or emotional distress, as an alternative to hospitalization.

The Crisis Residence Center is open 24/7 and is staffed by Mosaic Peer Specialists. Guests staying at the Center are offered a warm and supportive environment which includes learning skills from trained Peer Specialist in recovery and relapse prevention.

Mosaic's Crisis Residence Center is a new and innovative approach to providing community-based services to individuals experiencing a psychiatric crisis.

Services include:

- On-site Peer Support
- Health & Wellness Coaching
- Peer Run Group Therapy
- Care Coordination with Healthcare Providers
- Coordination with Social Services
- Family Support
- Medication Management/Monitoring





"A Home Away From Home"

Mosaic's Crisis Residence is centrally located in a tree-lined residential neighborhood in the Bronx, walking distance to local parks, restaurants, shops, and the library.

Easily accessible by public transportation, the Center offers guests private individual bedrooms, free Wi-Fi access, self-service laundry, and common areas such as a kitchen and dining room for meals and a living room with cable television.

Eligible Guests Must:

- Be 18 years of age or older
- Reside in the 5 boroughs
- Be Medically stable
- Have stable housing
- Voluntarily accept services
- Be experiencing a psychiatric crisis
- Not at imminent risk to self or others
